## 4. LIST MEASURES TAKEN TO CONTROL HAZARDS

- a) Instruct them how to slide safely and monitor, only one person on slide at a time, descend feet first. Only one person climbing wall at a time.
- b) Ensure cables are kept away from users and correct equipment used. Generators if used, turned off when refilled.
- c) Check daily and correct training in use. Daily operating checklist completed.
- d) If the equipment becomes dangerous because of the weather conditions, stop immediately
- e) Keep all groups away from any moving part and suitable barriers in place
- f) Trained personnel only, follow manufacturers guidelines, suitable training
