

MINI GOLF

RISK ASSESSMENT

Frequency of use Daily / AS REQUIRED

- 1. PEOPLE AT RISK** (instructors and visitors)
Up to 15 participants, plus leaders and/or instructors

- 2. POTENTIAL HAZARDS** (Anything with the potential to cause harm)
 - a) Uneven, wet surfaces
 - b) Failure to maintain or use equipment properly
 - c) Other site users, visitors

- 3. ASSESSMENT OF RISK**
 - a) Low
 - b) Low
 - c) Medium

- 4. LIST MEASURES TAKEN TO CONTROL HAZARDS**
 - a) Tell everyone to be careful when stepping on and off the course. Check suitable footwear.
 - b) Activity equipment checked pre start by activity leader. Participants asked not to swing golf clubs above waist height and to avoid hitting golf balls too hard.
 - c) Group leader to be aware of passing groups especially when Golf ball/(s) in motion.
